The centralised vacuum cleaning (CVC) systems are most effective where quantities of dust or other materials must be regularly removed from one or more floor levels to a central point, or where local conditions hinder the use of a mobile application. A series of connection points at key locations throughout the building are linked by a system of fixed pipework to a conveniently positioned repository. This allows material to be drawn from multiple locations to a central point for disposal or for recycling back into a process.

Clyde has also created customised solutions to meet individual and unique requirements. For example, Clyde has developed mobile applications for the Ministry of Defence for use aboard aircraft, for aircraft / helicopter maintenance. These applications also have NATO stock numbers. In addition, Clyde has created machines to food industry standards that have been able to collect spillages from conveyor lines.
